Music Theatre Scholarship Guidelines for 6-8 year olds

The Deer Park Arts Council (DPAC) presents scholarships to deserving students who meet the criteria determined by the Scholarship Committee and approved by the DPAC board.

The application must be received at the address noted below or DPAC school mailbox at the high school no later than June 1, 2018.

The Committee evaluates each candidate on the following criteria:

- The application must be completed in full.
- The candidate must have a grade point average of 80 or higher.
- A parent must have completed 6 hours of volunteer service for DPAC and contribute time towards "Deer Park Loves The Arts" at Geiger Park on July 21, 2018.
- Parent(s) of applicant must have attended 2 DPAC meetings before June 1, 2018.
- Candidate must submit a typewritten essay (no less than 100 words) on the following topic:
"What are your favorite things about singing, dancing and/or acting?"

DO NOT SIGN THE ESSAY. IF YOUR NAME IS ON THE ESSAY YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.

The final selection will be made at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee whose decision is final.

The scholarship winners will be awarded at "Deer Park Loves The Arts" on Saturday, July 21, 2018.

Place your unsigned essay in a plain envelope and submit with your application in another envelope addressed to the address below.
