7TH GRADE SCHOOL SUPPLIES 2018-2019

Students should have a supply of pens, pencils, pencil sharpener, highlighters, paper, and colored pencils that can be used in all classes. Students should also have three-ring binders and several folders that may be used for multiple classes. This list is as comprehensive as can be; however, teachers may require specific additional supplies once the school year begins. Hopefully, this list will give you a jump start on buying supplies during the summer.

- 12 Blue Ink Pens
- 12 Black Ink Pens
- 24 #2 Pencils
- 1 Yellow Highlighter
- 1 Pink Highlighter
- 4 Plastic folders in different colors (suggested plastic as paper tends to rip)
- 2 Packages of 200 sheet filler paper TO BE LEFT AT HOME! Only bring a small amount to school with you
- 2 Packages of 8 Tab Dividers
- 1 8X10 Pencil Pouch
- 3 1" 3 – ring binders
- 1 Marble Composition Book
- 4 Dry Erase Markers (Any colors)
- 1 Pack of colored pencils
- 1 4 oz. Elmer's school glue

Art: 1 9X12 sketch pad(no more than \$3), 1 box of pencils, 2 fine point flair markers, eraser, jumbo ziploc bag, pencil sharpener

Band: Reeds or valve oil

Chorus: 1 spiral music staff notebook and 1 pocket folder

Orchestra: folder, rosin; violin and viola - set of strings

General Music: 1 marble notebook and a two pocket folder

Physical Education: Sneakers and a change of clothes for all weather conditions (shorts & tee-shirt, sweat shirt & sweat pants), Ziploc bag to hold valuables in locker

Math and Science-Recommended 1 Texas Instrument TI-30XIIS Calculator

BOOKBAGS & LOCKER USAGE:

Students should have a good book bag to travel to and from school. It should be worn properly with the weight evenly distributed, heaviest items at the bottom, using the shoulder straps and waist belt. Before Home Base, they should put their jacket and book bag in their locker. For in-school use it is suggested that students use two drawstring book bags. One can be used for morning classes and the other for afternoon classes. This enables them to carry less throughout the school day. Rolling backpacks are not allowed in school except with permission from an administrator. Students will be expected to keep large backpacks in their lockers during the school day.
