Dear Parents/Guardians,

Please follow the following rules when dropping off your children for extra help in the morning.

- Students are not allowed into the building until 7:30 am. If you choose to drop them off before 7:30 am, they will be asked to wait outside regardless of the weather. We do not have teacher supervision available before that time.
- If you drop your child off in front of the building, please drive all the way down toward the student walkway. This will prevent a back-up of traffic on Half Hollow Road. It will also protect your children.
- The better choice would be to drop your children off at the Student Drop Off point in the Pitt Avenue parking lot, where drop off and pick up usually occur, and then your child can walk to the front door.
- You also have the option of using the Old Country Road parking lot and dropping your children off utilizing that side of the building as well so that everyone is not trying to use the front parking lot entrance.
- Anything you can do to alleviate the congestion in the morning will be appreciated.
- Please, DO NOT pass the other cars when dropping off in front of the school. Children are exiting the cars from both sides. It is very dangerous to speed up and pass other cars. A few extra moments of patience can help to avoid a potential tragedy.

Additionally, the law requires that all children wear a helmet when riding a bike. If your child arrives to school without a helmet, they will not be allowed to ride home that afternoon, and the bike will not be released to them until they bring a helmet to school.

Please remind your children to be conscious of their surroundings, to abide by all traffic rules, and to stay out of the roads.

If you have any questions about my requests, please do not hesitate to ask. My number one concern is the safety of your children.
