Dear Parents/Guardians:

The June 2019 testing period will be **Monday, June 3rd and Tuesday, June 18th through Tuesday, June 25th**. On June 3rd, the Global History Regents will be administered. Students enrolled in Global 2 must report to school to take the exam. School will be closed for all other students on that day. **The last day of classes will be Monday, June 17th**.

In order to be in compliance with the security procedures, all students must **empty their lockers by Thursday, June 13th at 2:10pm**. Lockers combinations will be changed beginning that afternoon. Parents/Guardians are to encourage their children to empty their lockers as early as possible, and return any textbooks to their classroom teacher prior to testing week.

During the testing days (June 3rd, June 18th – 25th), students must adhere to the following guidelines:

- Students are to report to school **only when they have a scheduled exam**.
- Students will not have access to lockers on the days of testing.
- Students must show identification when they enter the building.
- As per the New York State Board of Regents, **a test is considered invalid if an electronic device is used in any way during an exam**. If a student needs to bring a cell phone to the building, it must be in a clear plastic bag with their student ID. The bag with the cell phone and ID will be collected.
