College Application Process

- Counselor Meetings
 - (Students should schedule a <u>full period</u> appointment with their counselor beginning October 1st)
- Generate a list of colleges
 - Suggested- 3-4 "target", 1-2 "reach", 1-2 "safety"
 - www.collegeboard.org
- 2 Teacher Letters of Recommendation and 1 Counselor Letter
 - (Only if applying to 4 year colleges)
- Take the SAT or ACT
 - SAT www.collegeboard.org
 - Saturday, October 3^{rd**} and Saturday, November 7th
 - ACT www.actstudent.org
 - Saturday, October 24th and Saturday, December 12th
- Write the College Essay
- College Visitations
 - (Excused absence with a letter from the college)



College Application Process

- Keep track of Application Deadlines
 - Early Action vs. Early Decision
 - Regular Decision vs. Rolling Admissions
- Sending information to colleges
 - All Applications MUST be to Guidance TWO WEEKS prior to the deadline for letters of recommendation and transcripts to be sent
 - ➤ If you apply online to a college you MUST inform your Guidance Counselor within 24 hours of submission
- Students are responsible for:
 - Sending SAT and ACT scores to colleges directly through testing websites
 - Sending AP scores and college transcripts




- <u>College Visits:</u> College admissions representatives visit the H.S. to hold info sessions with interested students!



Eligibility Requirements

Academic and Discipline

- Academic
 - <u>Probation</u> Student who meets any or all of the following criteria:
 - Failing two (2) or more subjects as reported on the progress report or report card
 - Failed two (2) or more subjects in June of the previous school year.
 - Ineligible Student who meets any or all of the following criteria:





Eligibility Requirements

Discipline

- Probation A student is on probation if he/she meets any or all of the following criteria:
 - Has been suspended out of school on one (1) occasion during the current school year.
 - Has had two (2) incidents which resulted in administrative disciplinary consequences during the current school year.
 - Were deemed discipline ineligible in June of the previous school year.
- Ineligible A student is ineligible if he/she meets any or all of the following criteria:
 - Found guilty at a Superintendent's Hearing during the current school year.
 - Has been suspended out of school on two (2) separate occasions during the current school year.
 - Has had four (4) incidents which resulted in administrative disciplinary actions during the current school year.
