Students should have a supply of pens, pencils, highlighters, pocket folders as well as a usb drive (i.e. thumb drive or flash drive) that can be used in all classes. These lists are as comprehensive as can be; however, teachers may require specific additional supplies once the school year begins. Hopefully, this list will give you a jump start on buying supplies during the summer.

Specific additional needs are listed below:

<u>Language Arts:</u> 2 marble notebooks, 2 pocket folders, glue stick, post its, 1 box self-adhesive index tabs.

Social Studies: 1 marble notebook, 1 folder.

<u>Math</u>: One 1"(inch) three-ring binder with paper, Scientific Calculator suggested: Texas Instrument TI-30XIIS.

Science: 1 subject spiral notebook. 2 pocket folders.

<u>World Language</u>: One 1"-2"(inch) three-ring binder with loose-leaf paper, 5 dividers, colored pencils. **French**- package of 100 medium index cards

<u>Art</u>: 1 9X12 sketch pad(no more than \$3), 1 box of pencils, 2 fine point flair markers, eraser, jumbo zip lock bag, pencil sharpener.

Business Communication: A set of personal headphones.

Chorus: 1 spiral music staff notebook and 1 pocket folder.

Band: Reeds or valve oil.

<u>Orchestra</u>: folder, rosin; violin and viola - set of strings. **General Music**: 1 marble notebook and 1 pocket folder.

Reading: 1 marble notebook.

Health: 1 pocket folder.

<u>Physical Education</u>: Sneakers and a change of clothes for all weather conditions (shorts & tee-shirt, sweat shirt & sweat pants), Ziploc bag to hold valuables in locker. If you have not done so, you can purchase a good quality master lock during gym class for \$6.00 and use it every year.

BOOKBAGS & LOCKER USAGE:

Students should have a good book bag to travel to and from school. It should be worn properly with the weight evenly distributed, heaviest items at the bottom, using the shoulder straps and waist belt. Before Home Base, they should put their jacket and book bag in their locker. For in-school use it is suggested that students use two drawstring book bags. One can be used for morning classes and the other for afternoon classes. This enables them to carry less throughout the school day.
