7TH GRADE SCHOOL SUPPLIES 2011-2012

Students should have a supply of pens, pencils, highlighters, pocket folders as well as a usb drive (i.e. thumb drive or flash drive) that can be used in all classes. These lists are as comprehensive as can be; however, teachers may require specific additional supplies once the school year begins. Hopefully, this list will give you a jump start on buying supplies during the summer.

Specific additional needs are listed below:

Language Arts: Albrecht-One 1"(inch) binder(may be shared with Social Studies), loose-leaf paper, dividers; All other Language Arts teachers- one marble notebook and a folder.

<u>Social Studies</u>: Baudier/Cogan- One 1"(inch) binder, loose-leaf paper, dividers(may be shared with Language Arts). Bodt- 5-subject spiral notebook with pocket folder and dividers.

Math: Scientific Calculator suggested: Texas Instrument TI-30XIIS.

One 1"(inch) binder with paper and dividers, protractor, dry-erase markers.

<u>Science</u>: One 1"(inch) binder with paper and 4 dividers, calculator (can be same as math).

World Language: One 1"-2"(inch) binder with paper and 5 dividers, 1 dry erase marker, language dictionary for home use. **French**- package of 100 medium index cards

<u>Art:</u> 1 9X12 sketch pad(no more than \$3), 1 box of #2 pencils, 2 twin-tipped black sharpie markers, eraser, jumbo Ziploc bag, pencil sharpener.

Home & Careers: Notebook and folder.

General Music: 1 marble notebook and 1 pocket folder.

Chorus: 1 spiral music staff notebook and one pocket folder.

Band: Reeds and valve oil.

Orchestra: folder, rosin; violin and viola - set of strings.

AIS Reading: 1 marble notebook.

Technology: Elmer's glue, ruler, and 12 pencils.

Physical Education: Sneakers and a change of clothes for all weather conditions (shorts & tee-shirt, sweat shirt & sweat pants), Ziploc bag to hold valuables in locker. If you have not done so, you can purchase a good quality master lock during gym class for \$6.00 and use it every year.

BOOKBAGS & LOCKER USAGE:

Students should have a good book bag to travel to and from school. It should be worn properly with the weight evenly distributed, heaviest items at the bottom, using the shoulder straps and waist belt. Before Home Base, they should put their jacket and book bag in their locker. For in-school use it is suggested that students use two drawstring book bags. One can be used for morning classes and the other for afternoon classes. This enables them to carry less throughout the school day.
