Specific additional needs are listed below:

Math: Scientific calculator suggested: Texas Instrument TI-30XIIS

<u>Integrated Algebra:</u> All general math supplies listed above and Graphing calculator TI84 (optional).

<u>Science</u>: One 1"(inch) binder with paper and dividers, calculator (can use same as math), colored pencils, and ruler.

<u>Living Environment:</u> Calculator (can use same one as math), One 1"(inch) binder and dividers, colored pencils

<u>World Language</u>: One 1"(inch) binder with paper and 5 dividers; a package of 100 medium index cards; a language dictionary for home use.
