5. Bus Schedule:

AM TESTING: Regular AM pick up (7:30 am) Tuesday, June 18<sup>th</sup> through Monday, June 24<sup>th</sup>. There will be a bus run home at the end of the AM testing.

PM TESTING: On June 18<sup>th</sup> through June 21<sup>th</sup> regular bus route pick up will be at 11:30 a.m. There will be regular bus runs home at 2:10 p.m. On Tuesday, June 18<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday, June 19<sup>th</sup>, there will be an extra bus run home for 8<sup>th</sup> grade students taking Regents exams.
