Meeting was held in the district office Tuesday November 14, 2007. Septa board members, Administrators, Teachers, & parents attended.

Topics discussed

- 1) High School level skills – cognitive integrated class. Frank & I will discuss with Ms Cuttitta. Testing problems at the High School with special needs children. Issues at Frost with IEP goals.
- 2) Ronnie Gilbert volunteered to coach a special needs soccer indoor team. Ronnie played soccer through college & is also a certified gym teacher. We discussed getting an application to use one of the school gyms.
- 3) Social group for special needs children (after school program) eight week session 345pm-445pm once a week at JFK. Two teachers X 50\$ per hr & two teachers assistants 15\$ per hour. 1040 dollars would be the projected cost for an eight week session. SEPTA will ask the BOE for the funding and like to implement by Spring 08. Children would have a chance to make friends and play educational games. I would like to see this happen ASAP.
- 4) Septa will be sending out a survey to see what our children & parents are interested in. Bowling, soccer, social groups ECT. Septa dinner was a great success and they rose 8000\$. SEPTA will be looking to have a car show / flea market in the spring.
- 5) Bus # 48 driver issue (Frank) to address ASAP.
