Choose ONE of the following options:

Choice #1

Think of three different gifts that would be perfect to give to the main character. These gifts should be things that you feel he/she would really want or use. Explain why you chose each gift and how it fits your character (one paragraph minimum per gift)

## Choice #2

Write a book recommendation. Explain whether or not you would recommend this book to another student. Be sure to include the following:

- You must rate the book from 1 to 10
- Offer a clear explanation of why you feel the way you do
- Give examples from the book that support your recommendation. For instance, include a
  quote or quotes from the book or a summary of the part of the book that you liked or did
  not like.
