Choose <u>ONE</u> of the following works of literature to read:

Fish in a Tree by Lynda Mullaly Hunt Flying Solo by Ralph Fletcher
My Weird School Books by Dan Gutman

The Chronicles of Narnia: The Lion, The Witch, and The Wardrobe by CS Lewis The I Survived Series by Lauren Tarshis (one book from the series)

Choose <u>ONE</u> of the following Corresponding Assignments:

- 1. Think of three different gifts that would be perfect to give to the main character. These gifts should be things that you feel he/she would really want or use. Explain why you chose each gift and how it fits your character (one paragraph minimum per gift).
- 2. Write a book recommendation. Explain whether or not you would recommend this book to another student. Be sure to include the following:
 - a. You must rate the book from 1 to 10.
 - b. Offer a clear explanation of why you feel the way you you.
 - c. Give examples from the book that support your recommendation. For instance, include a quote or quotes from the book or a summary of the part of the book that you liked or did not like.
