Theodore Boone: Kid Lawyer by John Grisham

Choose <u>ONE</u> of the following Corresponding Assignments:

- 1. Discuss the author's craft. What things did the author do to make the book good (or not)? Be sure to include at least two specific examples of things the author did well or could have done better.
- 2. Find a job, either online or in a newspaper/magazine, that would be the best fit for the main character in the story. Find three examples from the book that show that the job is a good fit. Have a copy of the ad with this assignment.
- 3. Choose a character and write ten interview questions that could be answered using excerpts from the book. Write out the ten questions with the answers from the excerpts of the book.
